The International Day of Peace



The International Day of Peace ("Peace Day") is observed around the world each year on 21 September. Established in 1981 by unanimous United Nations resolution, Peace Day provides a globally shared date for all humanity to commit to Peace above all differences and to contribute to building a Culture of Peace.

Each year the International Day of Peace is observed around the world on 21 September. The General Assembly has declared this as a day devoted to strengthening the ideals of peace, both within and among all nations and peoples.

The United Nations Member States adopted the 17 Sustainable Development Goals in 2015 because they understood that it would not be possible to build a peaceful world if steps were not taken to achieve economic and social development for all people everywhere, and ensure that their rights were protected. The Sustainable Goals cover a broad range of issues, including poverty, hunger, health, education, climate change, gender equality, water, sanitation, energy, environment and social iustice.

Sustainable Development Goal 16 "Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions" The Universal Declaration of Human

calls for promoting peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, providing access to justice for all and building effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels.

A peaceful society is one where there is justice and equality for everyone. Peace will enable a sustainable environment to take shape and a sustainable environment will help promote peace.

The theme for the International Day of Peace in 2018 is "The Right to Peace - The Universal Declaration of Human Rights at 70" The theme celebrates the 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.



Rights is a milestone document in the history of human rights. Drafted by representatives with different legal and cultural backgrounds from all regions of the world, the Declaration was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in Paris on 10 December 1948 as a common standard of achievement for all peoples and all nations.

The Universal Declaration – the most translated document in the world, available in more than 500 languages - is as relevant today as it was on the day that it was adopted.

"It is time all nations and all people live up to the words of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which recognizes the inherent dignity and equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human race. This year marks the 70th anniversary of that landmark document." -- Secretary-General António Guterres

The Universal Declaration states in Article 3. "Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person." These elements build the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world.

Yet, the Universal Declaration does not include a separate article on "Right to Peace".

Human rights are everyone's rights.

Meet Celeste, the cow from udder space.




Unfortunately, the owner does not know the cow's breed. She was bought at an auction a few years ago.

There have been Coyote sightings near some neighborhoods in Comal County, specifically near Canyon Lake Dam and along Potters Creek road including the recreational area. Typically, they are Nocturnal, but it is not uncommon to see them in the early mornings. Merely seeing one is not a reason to call us as they are native wildlife here in Texas and live amongst us. However, there are certain behaviors that are cause for alarm.

Coyote in possession of a giant magnet

Coyote in possession of a catapult

Coyote detonating explosive/TNT

Coyote launching self with giant crossbow

She was hospitalized 4 times for dehydration throughout her pregnancy. At more dinners on the front steps of their home than he could count because any scent literally made her ill.

After months of simply being there for her as much as possible, he supported her during birth.

I told him I captured him crying seeing his son and he said, 'That's not why I was crying.'

Puzzled, I asked what he meant.

He teared up again and said,

'This is the first time I have seen her smile in 10 months'."
