# **Bastille Day**



#### **Bastille Day Facts**

Bastille Day, or the French National Day, is celebrated on July 14th every year in France. It is a day to celebrate and remember the beginning of the French Revolution, following the storming of the Bastille in Paris, which was a fortress and prison representing French Royalty in 1789. Following the Storming of the Bastille, Marie Antoinette and King Louis XVI fled, leaving the Bastille to be pillaged and burned. The Bastille itself was built in approximately the year 1370 to help defend Paris in the 100 Years War.

#### **Interesting Bastille Day Facts:**

• Bastille originates from the French word for stronghold - bastide.

- Beginning in 1417 the Bastille was a prison for those who opposed France's kings.
- From the period between 1420 and 1436 the English had control of the Bastille.
- King Louis XVI asked, "Is it a revolt?" when he learned of the attack on the Bastille. He was told "No Sire, it is a revolution."
- The mob that stormed the Bastille also stole all the weapons they could find to use in their revolution against the monarchy.
- After the Storming of the Bastille and prior to the formation of the French Republic in 1792 many aris-

tocrats were executed in France in what is referred to as 'The Reign of Terror'.

- Although the Bastille had enough space to hold 50 prisoners, when it was stormed there were only seven prisoners, including one deviant aristocrat, two lunatics and four forgers.
- Bastille Day became a national holiday in France in 1880, less than 100 years after the Storming of the Bastille.
- The French celebrate Bastille Day as a way to recognize the significance of the Storming of the Bastille as the end of the royal monarchy and the beginning of its modern republic.
- Bastille Day is celebrated in Paris with a parade on the Champs Elysees called the Bastille Day Military Parade. The Champs-Elysees is decorated with flags for the annual parade.
- The French President usually gives a speech following the Bastille Day Military Parade. This parade is the oldest European military parade.
- The Bastille Day Military Parade ends at the Arc de Triomphe, a large monument that honors those who died while fighting for France during the French Revolution and Napoleonic Wars.
- Most municipalities in France celebrate Bastille Day beginning with a Mayoral speech. This is often followed by a war memorial wreath-laying.
- France is not the only country to celebrate Bastille Day. In some parts of the United States, such as Milwaukee, Wisconsin, there is a Bastille Day celebration as well. In Milwaukee the celebration lasts four days and they even have a replica of the Eiffel Tower that is 43 feet in height.
- Bastille Day is celebrated in Belgium, the Czech Republic, Hungary, India, New Zealand, South Africa, the United Kingdom, and in the United States.
- The famous writer and philosopher Voltaire was once a prisoner of the Bastille.
- In addition to the Bastille Day Military Parade in Paris, there are fireworks, dances, music, food and street celebrations in Paris and across the rest of the country.

# SBA to Open Business Recovery Center in Muskogee to Help Businesses Impacted by Severe Storms, Straight-line Winds, Tornadoes and Flooding

**SACRAMENTO, Calif.** – The U.S. Small Business Administration and the Oklahoma Small Business Development Center today announced the opening of an SBA Business Recovery Center in Muskogee on Monday, June 24, to provide a wide range of services to businesses impacted by severe storms, straight-line winds, tornadoes and flooding that occurred May 7 - June 9, 2019.

"Due to the severe property damage and economic losses the severe storms, straight-line winds, tornadoes and flooding inflicted on Oklahoma businesses, we want to provide every available service to help get them back on their feet," said SBA's Director Tanya N. Garfield of the U.S. Small Business Administration's Disaster Field Operations Center-West. "The center will provide a one-stop location for businesses to access a variety of specialized help. SBA customer service representatives will be available to meet individually with each business owner," she added.

No appointment is necessary. All services are provided free of charge. The center will open as indicated below.

"SBA customer service representatives will meet with each business owner to explain how an SBA disaster loan can help finance their recovery. They will answer questions about SBA's disaster loan program, explain the application process and help each business owner complete their electronic loan application," Garfield said.

According to State Director Michele Campbell, Oklahoma Small Business Development Center business advisors are available by appointment to provide business assistance to clients on a wide variety of matters designed to help small business owners re-establish their operations, overcome the effects of the disaster and plan for their future. "Services include assessing business working capital needs, evaluating the business's strength, cash flow projections, and most importantly, a review of options with the business owner to help them evaluate their alternatives and make decisions that are appropriate for their situation," she said.

According to Garfield, businesses of any size and private nonprofit organizations may borrow up to \$2 million to repair or replace damaged or destroyed real estate, machinery and equipment, inventory, and other business assets. These loans cover losses that are not fully covered by insurance or other recoveries.

For small businesses, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and most private, nonprofit organizations of any size, SBA offers Economic Injury Disaster Loans to help meet working capital needs caused by the disaster. Economic Injury Disaster Loan assistance is available regardless of whether the business suffered any property damage.

For business owners who are unable to visit the business recovery center, they may apply online using SBA's secure website at https://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela.

SBA representatives will meet with business owners and residents at disaster recovery centers located throughout the impacted area as they are established. For a list of locations, or to receive additional disaster assistance information, visit SBA's website at www.sba.gov/disaster. Applicants may also call SBA's Customer Service Center at (800) 659-2955 or email disastercustomerservice@sba.gov for more information. Individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing may call (800) 877-8339. Completed applications should be mailed to U.S. Small Business Administration, Processing and Disbursement Center, 14925 Kingsport Road, Fort Worth, TX 76155.

The deadline to apply for property damage is July 31, 2019. The deadline to apply for economic injury is March 2, 2020.





"Hi!" wrote Kalvet. "I stumbled onto your Twitter page completely by chance and after a bit of scrolling was surprised to see your tweet about an Estonian book. I am writing to you to ask if you'd actually want an edition of it because as I live in Estonia... I could get you one!"

Kalvet explained that original editions of Karp could be bought in second-hand bookshops in Estonia for around £2.50 ( $\in$ 3) – and in April, a copy wrapped in brown paper dropped through Goldstone's letterbox.

"It is a story of the sweet generosity of a stranger," said Goldstone.

# A man who volunteers at his local animal shelter daily went viral for taking naps with the specialneeds cats.





Then I studied really hard. I left my mother and came to Seoul and studied, and got accepted in the Seoul University with all the confidence I had. Then, I got married. I bought a house of my own. Then I had kids, too. Now I'm living happily as a successful man. I like it here because it's a place that doesn't remind me of my mom.


There was a time when this sort of thing would have embarrassed the hell out of me. Or I'd have been way to shy and awkward to say such a thing. Not now. Now I must!

# They help me, I help them




